## A RUNAWAY WORLD CONCEPT NOTE AND SESSIONS

The world is facing a multitude of crises, including geopolitical tensions, economic downturns, rising inequalities, and the impact of climate change. These issues are exacerbated by weakened international institutions, societal polarization, and the resurgence of autocratic regimes, leading to a breakdown of the existing rules-based international order.

This involves fostering unity among EU member states, increasing investments in technology and innovation, and addressing security and economic challenges while maintaining a commitment to multilateralism.
